

REYNOLDS TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES

6.8.17

Supervisor Kindel called the regular Meeting of the Board to order at 7:00 pm, Pledge of Allegiance was given.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Supervisor Kindel, Clerk Sholty, Treasurer Stedman, Trustee Eversole and Trustee Saucier.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Public comment was given regarding tannerite, firearm shooting throughout the day/night and semi-automatic firearm shooting; request to look into zoning rules and regulations.

Request of Fire Chief to attend meeting once a year for updates with fire department.

CONSENT AGENDA: Deputy McConnell presented the Police Report and Zoning Administrator Mark Stevens presented the Zoning Report.

Motion: Approve consent agenda consisting of May 11, 2017 regular Meeting of the Board minutes, Police Report, Fire Report, Zoning Report, Treasurer's Report, Library Report and the Township Monthly Bills. Motion by Sholty, 2nd by Eversole, Ayes: 5, Nays: 0, Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Discussion regarding ADA compliant Township Hall Door. 3 estimates received. ADA EZ Wire Free Door operator, easily installed, charges every time door is opened and needs to be recharged after 35 push button uses, for about \$1,000.00 less. Motion: Order ADA EZ Wire Door at a cost of \$1789.47 and township will install. Motion by Sholty, 2nd by Stedman, Ayes: 5, Nays: 0, motion carried.

Update on Tax Account: Treasurer has sent requested information to Auditor.

Cemetery Update: Some items have been removed, will need to make rounds for items that will need to be removed. 124 headstones have been cleaned in the old addition, will continue with headstone cleaning.

Cleanup Day Results: 31.42 tons removed at an approx. cost of \$3,942. Under budget approx. \$1058.

Discussion regarding moving the remaining monies from the cleanup day to Cemetery Capital Outlay for continued headstone cleaning. Motion: Apply monies left from Cleanup Day to Cemetery Capital Outlay. Motion by Eversole, 2nd by Stedman, Ayes: 5, Nays: 0, Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Music in the Park Donation. Motion: Make a \$500 donation to Music in the Park. Motion by Sholty, 2nd by Eversole, Ayes: 5, Nays: 0, Motion carried.

BOARD COMMENTS: Trustee Eversole asked permission to continue to monitor the Kass property and will get in touch with DEQ for possibilities of major companies dumping illegally as there has been no results from attorney letters.

Supervisor Kindel: Ongoing dispute with resident wanting to be removed from tax roll.
