November 10, 2016

Supervisor Kindel called the regular Meeting of the Board to order at 7:00 pm., Pledge of Allegiance was given. Invocation given by Associate Pastor Mike Belson, First Baptist Church, Howard City.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Public Comment regarding medical marijuana laws, asking the Board's consideration to allow medical marijuana dispensaries and create an ordinance as soon as possible. Discussion regarding Manufactured Home Ordinance.

Election Day update given. Reynolds Township selected for post-election audit. Election workers did a very awesome job. Due to increased number of registered voters and the township hall unable to accommodate voters, a new polling place is being sought out.
